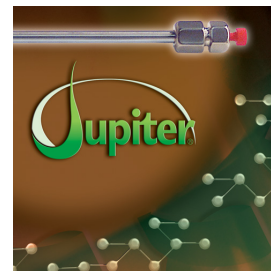

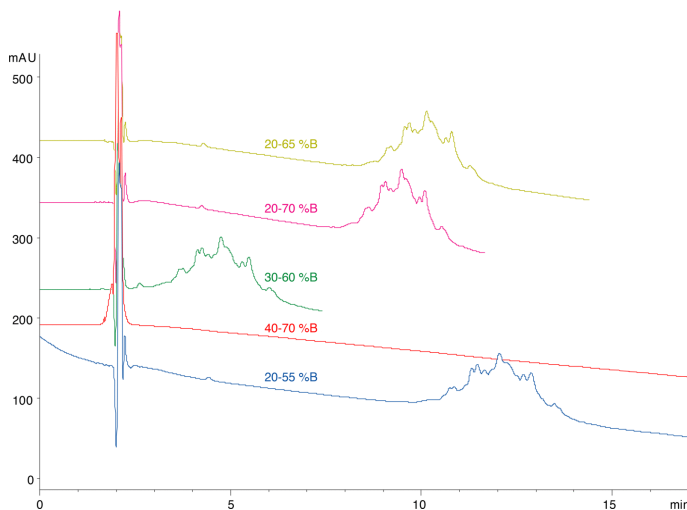

Detection: UV-Vis Abs.-Variable Wave.(UV) @ 214 nm (ambient)

Analyst Note: Reversed phase runs of PEGylated ribonuclease A using different gradient conditions on a Jupiter 300 C4 column (gradient length = 25 min) show that if initial %B is increased much above 25% then retention and resolution of PEGylated forms is lost. Gradient slopes between 2-4%/min
